

ROBERTS GOOD NEIGHBOR DAYS DEMOLITION DERBY RULES

Date: June 1st 2008 1st Heat – 3:00 PM Sharp

Cars must enter through pit gate before 2:00 PM unless pre-registered then must be in the gate by 2:30. **NO EXCEPTIONS**

Maximum of 30 cars per class

\$25.00 Entry Fee and Release Form should be received by May 23, 2008

There will be three classes this year

Stock Compact

Stock Full-size

Old Iron

(We will need a minimum of six cars to run each class)

Mike will determine class placement.

Payout based on total number of entries for each class.

RULES

DRIVERS: MAXIMUM OF THREE PITMEN PER CAR ALLOWED (Entry fee covers: 1 car, 1 driver, and one pit man)

1. Must be 18 years of age or older (NO EXCEPTIONS)
2. Must use safety approved helmet. (Motorcycle/snowmobile type)
3. All classes can use extra door protection (Can not add to the front or rear end strength of the car)
4. ANY CAR THAT I FEEL IS UNSAFE WILL NOT RUN !!!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

VEHICLES: All cars will be inspected and cars found not to be in compliance with the rules will not be allowed in the pit area until noncompliance is resolved.

General rules for Full and Compact classes:

1. Paint any number you wish on both front doors, if any duplication occurs, the first entry with that number gets to keep it
2. No hearses, El' Caminoes, Rancheros, Imperials, or pick-ups allowed
3. No trailer hitches or after market devices that protrude from the cars natural bodyline
4. DOT legal passenger car or light truck tires only **LT or P type tires only**
5. No added materials to the inside of the frame (**Automatic ejection from the park, loss of registration fee and any winnings**)
6. Hoods **must be** opened for inspection and chained down after inspection
7. All glass, including windshield and bulbs must be removed before entering the pit area
8. No plate anywhere on car
9. Doors must be chained or welded only (no ropes or wires)
10. No wiring of throttle
11. Seat beats must be bolted securely to the floor and worn in the arena
12. Gas tanks must be mounted securely to the floor and covered (Stock tank must be removed from the car)
13. Battery must be covered and mounted securely to the floor as far from the gas tank as possible
14. Vehicles must be equipped with stock fans and radiators mounted in stock positions (No additional radiators)

15. No chain with links larger than three inches
16. Not following rules and guidelines will result in automatic ejection from park, loss of registration fee, and any winnings NO EXCEPTIONS

STOCK CLASS RULES (FULL SIZE, COMPACT-SIZE)

1. Chains, hood pins, or threaded rod (max. diameter ½") must be used for hood and trunk. No welding that could strengthen the frame or body NO ¾ INCH ROD !!!!!!!
2. Zero welding on the car except the doors and bumper shocks. Special requests need prior approval of Mike Odden
3. Driver safety bars can be added in front of and/or behind driver's seat (Max. diameter = 's 3")
4. Zero reinforcement of the frame, body or bumpers
5. **Non-compliance will require removal from the pit and park area**

OLD IRON

You may do whatever you wish to the car but you have to have a radiator. **No exceptions—no radiator – no race.**

1. Must be 18 years of age or older (NO EXCEPTIONS)
2. Must use safety approved helmet. (Motorcycle/snowmobile type)

DERBY GUIDELINES

1. Must have contact with another running car (flag intact) at least every minute
2. **ANY** contact with a driver's door without attempting to stop will result in disqualification (Black Flagged)
3. **RED FLAG MEANS STOP MOVING IMMEDIATELY!**
4. No speed above 15 MPH will be allowed
5. No one allowed in arena except drivers, judges, towing crews, and emergency personnel
6. Winner is last one to make contact and still move
7. **Decisions of the judges will be final in ALL cases!**
8. The ROBERTS LIONS CLUB, VILLAGE OF ROBERTS or ANYONE AT ALL CONNECTED WITH THIS DERBY will not accept any responsibility for injuries, lost possessions, or damage to property of drivers or pit crews entering this contest
9. Pre-registration or gate entry is mandatory
10. 30 car limit for all classes
11. **No rain date will be scheduled.** If pre-registered, a refund or your check will be returned to you
